



MTG Scarf Patterns

(I use Michael's 40% off coupon whenever possible or pick up sales.
I've also used some wool I had on hand)

1.

Use size 3 ³/₄ or 4 needles with Canadiana or Patons wool or equivalent.

Cast on 24 stitches.

Knit 6 rows.

Pattern rows:

1st row: K6, P4, K4, P4, K6

2nd row: K2, P4, K4, P4, K4, P4, K2

3rd & 4th Rows: Repeat rows 1 & 2.

5th Row: K2, P4, K4, P4, K4, P4, K2

6th Row: K6, P4, K4, P4, K6

7th & 8th Rows: Repeat rows 5 & 6

Continue knitting these 8 rows until scarf measures at least 5'.

Knit 6 rows and cast off.

Use a 4.50 crochet hook to add colored wool fringe:

Cut 4 20" pieces of each color and using a 4.50 crochet hook add colored wool fringe (red, green, purple, yellow and blue). Or leave scarf without a fringe and let the office look after it.

2.

Use Size 3 ³/₄ or 4 needles with Canadiana wool or equivalent

Cast on 20 stitches. (more stitches can be added to make a wider scarf)

Knit 6 rows each of red, green, purple, yellow and blue.

Change to white or off white and knit every row until scarf measures 5'

Knit 6 rows each of blue, yellow, purple, green and red.

Ends will match and a white or off white fringe can be added.

3.

Using Size 5 needles with Bernat Softee Chunky

Cast on 22 sts.

Knit 6 rows.

Pattern:

1st Row: K3, P2, K12, P2, K3

2nd Row: K5, P12, K5

Repeat these 2 rows twice.

7th Row: K3, P2, (Cable following 12 sts as follows: put 3 sts on small cable needle to BACK of row and knit next 3 sts, knit 3 sts on cable needle. Put next 3 sts on cable needle at FRONT of row and knit next 3 sts, then knit 3 sts on cable needle.)P2, K3

8th Row: K5, P12, K5.

Continue with this 8 row pattern until scarf measures 5'

Knit 6 rows and cast off.

Add colored fringe as with other scarf patterns.
