



MTG Crochet Pattern for Scarf

Using Red Heart medium worsted wool or similar & 4.50 crochet hook

With main color: White/off white or navy blue, Chain 18

Turn and sc in 3rd chain and continue sc across 15 sts.

Row 2: Chain 2 and turn, and sc into the back of 2nd loop. Continue across row.

Row 3: Chain 2 and turn, and sc (regular) into 2nd loop.

Rows 4-10: Repeat these two rows 3 times.

Row 11: Attach one of suggested colors (Red, Purple, Green, Yellow & Blue) Chain 2 and turn. Repeat Rows 2 & 3 (3 times) Repeat these row, changing colors until all 5 colors are done. Then continue with pattern in the main color until the scarf measures 4'.

Starting with last color used and crocheting the colors so that they match the beginning stripes, continue with the pattern, ending with 9 rows of the main color.

MTG Crochet Pattern for Scarf

Using Red Heart medium worsted wool or similar & 4.50 crochet hook.

NOTE: Each row begins and ends with a 4" fringe in whatever color you are using, and ends with a chain pulled tightly. You begin each row at the other end of the scarf, by attaching wool into chain loop at the end, then chain 2 before putting the 1st sc in the back of first loop. ALL sc is into only the back loop and the right side is always facing you as you do this pattern.

With main color: White/off white or navy, Chain 250 leaving a 4" fringe at each end.

Foundation Row: With main color, beginning in last ch. and leaving a 4" end, work 1 sc in the back loop of each ch to end of row (250 sc). Fasten off leaving a 4" end.

Row 2: Repeat this row.

Row 3 & 4: Change to one of the colors suggested: Purple, and repeat Rows 1 & 2.

Row 5: Change to main color and crochet * 1 sc in back loop of 5 sc, then work 5 dbl crochet by picking up the loop on the last main color sc row*. Repeat this 10 st. crochet pattern * to * across row & fasten off, leaving a 4" end.

Row 6 & 7: Change to 2nd color: Gold and crochet 2 rows as Rows 1 & 2.

Row 8: Repeat Row 5.

Row 9 & 10: Change to 3rd color: Green and crochet 2 rows as Rows 1 & 2.

Row 11: Repeat Row 5.

Row 12 & 13: Change to 4th color: Red and crochet 2 rows as Rows 1 & 2.

Row 14: Repeat Row 5.

Row 15 & 16: Change to final color: Blue and crochet 2 rows as Rows 1 & 2.

Row 17: Repeat Row 5.

Row 18: Repeat row 1 with main color..

To Finish:

Using a large sewing needle, secure the 4" fringe at the beginning of each row.
