JOB PURPOSE:

The Children/Youth Director provides a discipleship and outreach ministry to youth from the Church and the local community

RESPONSIBILITIES:

The incumbent is responsible for the following range of job duties:

- Promotes and supervises all existing programs for children and youth within the Corps.
- Contributes to the spiritual development of the children and youth by mentoring, discipling, encouraging and modeling appropriate Christian attitudes and behaviors.
- Seeks to develop new ministries where possible, to increase the level of spiritual maturity among our children and youth and to provide outreach to the unsaved.
- Provides pastoral support to all children and youth that may be involved in various ministries.
- Plans, promotes and provides supervision for special events, i.e. Rally Days, VBS, Camps and Divisional Youth initiatives.
- Co-ordinates, implements and assists in the evaluation of programs/ministries relevant to the children and youth of the Corps and the community at large.
- Plans and conducts creative worship services, evangelistic outreach, care programs and Bible Study as applicable.
- Develops and implements appropriate leadership programs for youth and those involved in youth leadership.
- Recruits and trains volunteer leaders.
- Conducts regular leadership team meetings
- Maintains written records, logs of activities, including activity reports and statistical information.
- Organizes and holds fundraising events throughout the year.
- Performs general office duties and other duties as assigned.
- Participates in the preparation of budgets with respect to the Youth Department.
- Interacts with community partners and resources to provide services to youth which may include participation on community committees.
- Being involved with school activities where applicable. i.e. Bible Study, Breakfast Programs, etc.
- Helps in leading worship as required.
- Other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS:

The successful candidate must:

- Embody and reflect strong personal Christian commitment and Spiritual maturity.
- Have a passion for youth and youth ministry.
- Be a Salvation Army soldier (preferred but not necessary) who adheres to and supports the Mission, Policies and Principles of The Salvation Army.
- Have demonstrated successful involvement in working with the church youth. (One year or prior related experience working with children and youth.)
- Have completed high school
- Have musical and computer skills and be proficient in Microsoft Office Products including PowerPoint, Publisher and Word.
- Obtain a Criminal Police Check and clearance through The Salvation Army Internal Abuse Registry

- Be willing to work in a rural community and embrace the culture of small town living.
